## **Discoveries Around the Temples of Angkor**

What comes up mostly in the comments of our runners is the enthusiasm of the villagers who encourage them along the trails. This year, we wanted you to discover the daily life of the welcoming and smiling population.

#### Day 1: THURSDAY, 02/02/23 - SIEM REAP (Arrival)

Welcome by the driver (WITHOUT A GUIDE) at Siem Reap's airport, then transfer and check-in at the hotel.

Note: Rooms are available from 14h00.

**Dinner is at leisure.** 

Overnight in Siem Reap.

#### • <u>Day 2:</u> FRIDAY, 03/02/23 – SIEM REAP

At around **08:00 a.m**. after breakfast, depart from the hotel, <u>by an</u> <u>electric bike or mountain bike depending on your choice</u>, for a wonderful day of exploration of the majestic site of **Angkor**, classified in 1992 as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Visit the ancient capital of **Angkor Thom**, a vast architectural complex with the famous Bayon at its center. This mountaintemple was once surrounded by 54 towers. On each of the 37 remaining stone figures, four enigmatic faces can still be recognized. Then, discover the fascinating **Ta Prohm Temple**, undoubtedly one of the most famous monuments along with

Angkor Wat and the Bayon. Swallowed by the jungle, its ruins are now invaded by roots of kapok trees resembling giant snakes.

And to end the morning, visit a smaller stone temple of the 12<sup>th</sup> century, **Ta Nei**, that is very rarely visited. Built during the reign of King Jayavarman VII, discover the magic of the semi-ruined, untouristed jungle temple displaying classic Jayavarman VII artistry.

#### $\mathbf{R}^{T}$ Lunch is at a local restaurant.

In the afternoon, visit **Angkor Wat**, the most famous of the mountain temples. It is entirely dedicated to Vishnu, the supreme god of Hinduism and was built in the early 12<sup>th</sup> century by Suryavarman II. The temple is considered a masterpiece of Khmer art and

architecture. Its temple walls are decorated with thousands of bas relief symbolizing prominent deities and figures in the Hindi and Buddhist religions.

In the late afternoon, visit a **handicraft center** and discover the Cambodian natural essence.




#### Angkor, the former capital of the Khmer Empire.

#### IN OPTION: Tonle Sap Lake Excursion : Supplement 50 € /person




At around 08:00 a.m., depart to **Kompong Khleang**, a village located 50 km from Siem Reap, surrounded by a flooded forest, where one of the largest lake communities of Tonle Sap live mainly on fishing. On arrival, board on a small boat for a wonderful exploration of the daily life of the villagers. Stop at a village of Vietnamese community and visit their smoked fish factory. This part of the lake is also home to astonishing houses on stilts that can rise more than 10 meters above the ground during the dry season

Return back to Siem Reap in the late morning.

#### IN OPTION: Quad and Ziplining Adventure: Supplement 165 €/person



At around 08:00 a.m., depart for an **exciting quad ride through the countryside** of Siem Reap. Stop in rural villages and rice fields to be completely immersed with the local population. Afterward, set off for a **thrilling zipline experience through the rainforest canopy surrounding the temples of Angkor**. Take a fearless leap and enjoy a bird's eye view of the Angkor Archaeological Park. It is indeed a once in a lifetime experience in one of the most beautiful places in Cambodia.

Enjoy a picnic lunch in the countryside and return back to Siem Reap after lunch

**NOTE**: This excursion is reserved for people weighing less than 130 kilos and over 18 years old - 1 person per quad.

Depending on the flight schedule, transfer to the airport by the driver (WITHOUT A GUIDE) for the departure flight.

Note : Rooms shall be released at 12h00 (noon).
